- How do you send out loads ? Via email or we just call in ?




A no is not always a no in the beginning. You have to feel your way thru the situation. This is the job of every broker agent in the industry. You have to be able to close the deal.



What are you looking for and why ?

- Your looking to see if they will work with a Broker Firm.
